

Still growing interest for Swegon Air Academy seminars

The Swegon Air Academy has now been going in practice for more than five years and the interest for the seminars is still growing. In spite of the market state, inquiries for seminars all over Europe have increased during the last year. During 2010 we have already plans for 32 seminars, – four of them in the U.S. The 2010 seminars started in St Petersburg the 18th of February with a new participant record – close to 200 participants.



Important topics handled at the Swegon Air Academy seminars

One of the topics we are focusing at this year, is the importance of good air quality and the right temperature in schools for the children's school-work performance. For this purpose we have a close co-operation with Professor David Wyon, who is showing new findings from very extensive research at the Technical University in Denmark.

By securing the right indoor climate in schools, children's performance can be improved with up to 30 %. The

importance of indoor climate in schools is on the agenda in many European countries today and the Swegon Air Academy wants to contribute to widening the awareness of the present situation and what can be done to improve the indoor climate conditions.

Another topic that we are often asked to talk about is Demand Controlled Ventilation (DCV). We all know that we have to reduce our use of energy dramatically to avoid really

big problems in the future. We also know that we have to ventilate. We want to point out the possibilities with Demand Controlled Ventilation – to ventilate as much as needed, but not more. In May at the 10th REHVA World Congress Clima 2010 conference in Antalya in Turkey, the Swegon Air Academy will host a workshop on this topic together with Professor Per Fahlen from Chalmers University in Gothenburg.
